This exciting group exhibition of handcrafted furniture truly blurs the line between craft and art — each piece is unique in both design and execution.

Gary Magakis' waxed bronze side tables, floor lamps and cabinets are highlighted with steel and copper accents. **Jeffrey Brosk**, an MIT-trained architect turned sculptor, presents tables and wall sculptures of weathered cherry and slate. Noted blacksmith **Michael Saari's** new works in steel include a bedside table with unique hand forged legs. **Jack Brubaker's** forged steel lamps and hot bent iron pipe sculptural tables evoke the feeling of Art Nouveau. **Dana Major's** eclectic ceramic lamps are delightful in style and attitude, inspired by Russian folk tales. **John Rais's** steel works include fireplace screens and work tables of cherry and steel. **David Cramer's** carved wood works are whimsical sculptural masterpieces. **Tom Throop** creates masterful furniture that's beautiful to look at and comfortable to live with.
